

from Young's intention that the colonists should go so far north as they did. It was supposed by him that the colonists would settle somewhere in Snake River valley, possibly in the neighborhood of the present site of Idaho falls.

Father served four missions among the Indians on the Wind river Indian Agency and baptized several hundred Indians. Records of his missionary work exist in the archives of the church as he made reports of all he did. He also served as a sort of a scout in company with Moses Thatcher and President Lorenzo Dowd one summer through the Wind River Agency and on through Yellowstone National Park. He also played an active part in the early settlement of Teton Lake County in the Drilling's of the early 1860's. In the Indians, largely because of his ability to speak their language; and he was among the first to settle that valley in 1863. E. M. Wright
